100+ Years of Scouting History


- Mission is to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes




Scout Focused Organization

Boy Scouts / Varsity Scouting / Venturing

Boy Scouts (Troops)

- Scouts at least 10 years old but not yet 18
- Objectives of developing character, citizenship, and personal fitness

Varsity Scouting (Teams)

- Young men between the ages of 14 and 18
- Flexible program based on community needs

Venturing (Crews)

- Scouts at least 13 through 20 years of age
- Venturing crews can specialize in a variety of avocation or hobby interests
